Have you ever + PP II +?	- Have you ever played tennis? - Have you ever drunk wine?	- Yes, I have. - No, I haven't.

Lưu ý: PP II = past participle: quá khứ phân từ 2 - là dạng động từ được chia ở dạng quá khứ, thường được thêm đuôi -ed, trừ các động từ bất quy tắc, cụ thể:




