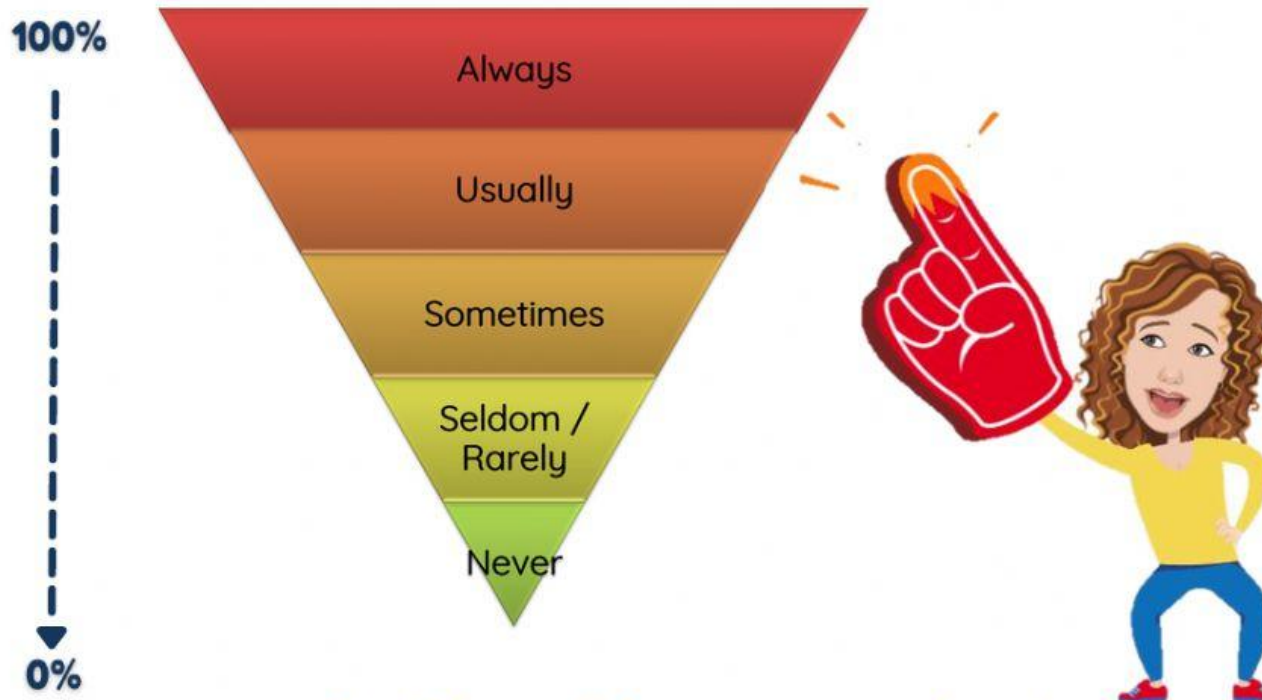


FREQUENCY ADVERBS

Study the frequency adverbs reference below. Pay attention to the position of these adverbs in the sentence. (Estude os advérbios de frequência abaixo. Preste atenção na posição dos advérbios nas frases.)



Position of frequency adverbs:

Affirmative	Vicky usually <u>drives</u> to work.	before the main verb = antes do verbo principal
	Vicky <u>is</u> never late for work.	after the verb to be = depois do verbo principal
Negative	Vicky <u>doesn't</u> usually <u>walk</u> .	after the auxiliary (don't/doesn't) = depois do auxiliar
	Vicky <u>isn't</u> often late for work.	after the verb to be (negative) = depois do verbo to be no negativo
