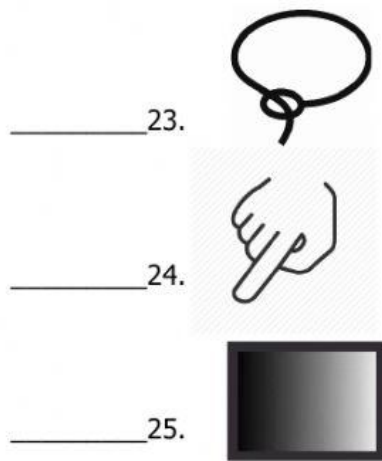

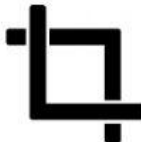

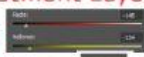

31-50. Using Adobe Photoshop, perform "**Blemish Removal**". See instructions below.

1. File>Open> (Select your image)
2. Unlock **background layer**
3. Create **Black & White Adjustment Layer** 
4. Decrease **Reds** and **Yellows** 
5. Create **Curves Adjustment Layer**  Put under **Black & White Adjustment Layer**
6. Drag up shadows 
7. Create **blank layer**
8. Select  **Healing Brush Tool** Hold **Alt** key then paint on the blemishes
9. Save copy as: **.psd** and **.png/.jpeg**
