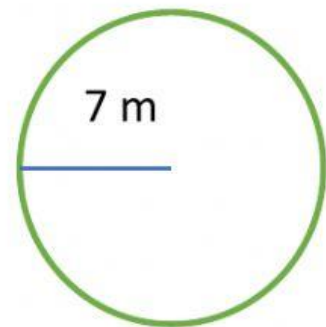
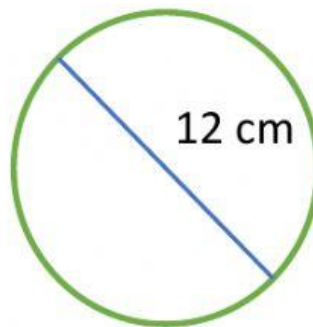
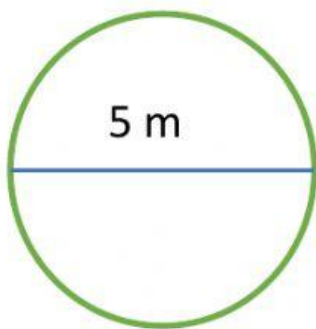


# Circumference

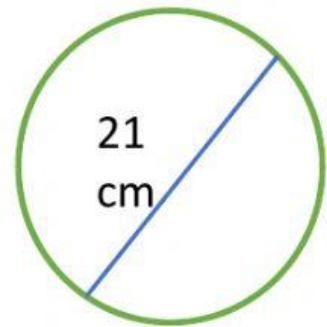
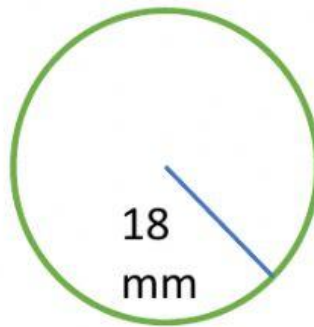
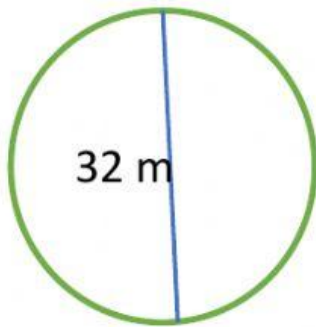
- Remember you will need the diameter or radius to help you find the circumference of a circle.
