Task 3: Here are three examples of a lawyer's writing. All three examples are extracts from contracts. A client asks his lawyer what each extract means. Write a, b or c to match each piece of writing with the explanation given by the lawyer below.

Extracts from contracts

- a. In the event of the death of the Supplier the rights and obligations under this Agreement shall be terminated forthwith.
- b. In the event that any property of the Contractor is lost or damaged in the course of transportation then the Contractor shall be entitled to compensation from the company.
- c. The company shall allow the Distributor to have full and complete control over the manner and the extend of the exploitation and advertisement of the product in the Territory.

The Lawyer's explanations

..... "If any of your property is lost or damaged on the journey then the company will pay for it"

..... "you will have complete control of the advertising of the product in the area of the word that we agreed"

..... "If you die then this contract will end immediately"
