Every year, on March <sup>17<sup>th</sup></sup>, the city of Chicago in the United States, does something unusual. They change the color of the water that runs through the city. They use food colouring to turn the water green. They use about 100 kilograms of this vegetable-based dye for the water. They do this to celebrate an Irish saint, Saint Patrick.

Many St Patrick's Day celebrations involve a lot of food and drinks. Some of the food and drinks are green too. Another tradition is to wear green. And if you do not, someone may just kick you. But Chicago is only one place that celebrates St Patrick. People in cities and around the world celebrate him. St Patrick is the Patron Saint of Ireland. He is known for his kind work on that island.

In the 1700 and 1800 large groups of Irish immigrants moved to the United States. This spread St Patrick's Day celebrations to many communities there. But the United States and Ireland are not the only places that celebrate this holiday. People in C hina, A merica, S ingapore, A ustralia, Argentina, Japan and R ussia all celebrate St Patrick's Day.

But the biggest celebrations today are in I reland. Today, in the city of Dublin, about 1.5 million people take part in St Patrick's festival. This celebration is 3 days long. It includes parades, music, dancing, fireworks and more.
