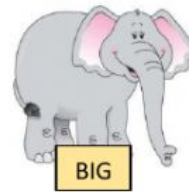
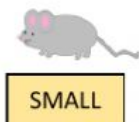

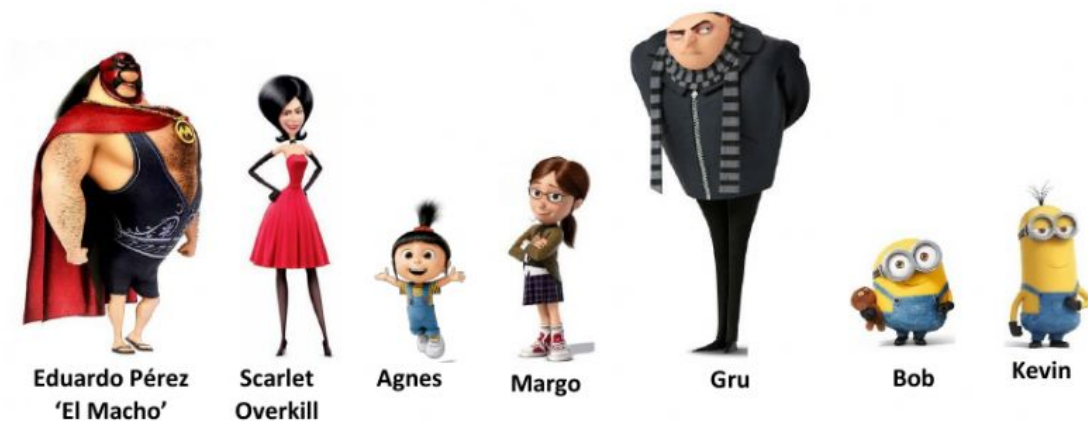

COMPARATIVES	
SHORT ADJECTIVES	LONG ADJECTIVES
-To compare 2 things	-To compare 2 things
Adjective (short)+ er + than	More + Adjective (long) + than
For example: Homer is older than Maggie.	For example Lisa is more serious than Bart.
 Homero es más viejo que Maggie.	 Lisa es más seria que Bart.

Adjectives that end in **CVC (consonant vowel consonant)** have an additional rule. **The last letter is repeated.**

For example:
FAT + ER + THAN → FATTER THAN

CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) → lleva doble T

Adjectives that end in **Y** have an additional rule. **The letter Y turns into an I.**

For example:
FUNNY + ER + THAN → FUNNIER THAN

La Y se convierte en i.

SUPERLATIVES	
SHORT ADJECTIVES	LONG ADJECTIVES
-To compare 3 things	-To compare 3 things
The + adjective (short)+ est	the + most + adjective (long)
For example: Homer is <u>the oldest</u> in the family.	For example Lisa is <u>the most serious</u> person in the family.
	
Homero es <u>el más viejo</u> de la familia.	Lisa es <u>la más seria</u> de la familia.

Adjectives that end in **CVC (consonant vowel consonant)** have an additional rule. The last letter is repeated.

For example:

THE + FAT + EST → THE FATTEST

CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) → lleva doble T

Adjectives that end in **Y** have an additional rule. The letter Y turns into an I.

For example:

THE + FUNNY + EST → THE FUNNIEST

La **Y** se convierte en **i**.
