

## Affirmative and negative sentences in the Past Simple Tense.

+ I **went** shopping on Monday.

- I **didn't go** shopping on Tuesday.

In an **affirmative sentence** we use the **2nd form of the verb.** (worked, went, saw)

In a **negative sentence**, after didn't we use the **1st form of the verb.** (work, go, see)
