

## Affirmative and negative sentences in the Past Simple Tense.

- + I **went** shopping on Monday.
- I **didn't go** shopping on Tuesday.

In **an affirmative** sentence we use the **2nd** form of the verb. (worked, went, saw)  
In **a negative sentence**, after didn't we use the **1st** form of the verb. (work, go, see)
