Rules

To form the Simple Past of regular verbs you add **-ed** or **-d** to the verb:

ask – asked

dance – danced

invite – invited

When the verb ends in **-y** preceded by a consonant you do like this:

Study – studied

When the verb ends in a consonant preceded by a stressed vowel you double the consonant:

travel – travelled

shop – shopped

The **-ed** at the end of the verbs may sound like **(t)**, **(d)** or **(id)**:

asked

danced

invited
