#### INFINITIVE WITHOUT TO

We use infinitive without TO in these expressions: **make someone do something/let someone do something**.

Compare these examples:

**NOT CORRECT:** He let me **to do** the test again.      **Correct:** He let me **do** the test again

**NOT CORRECT:** He made us **to stay** at work late.      **Correct:** He made us **stay** at work late.
