

S' OR 'S?

s' is used when the word ends with a "s" or it can be when the word is in the plural form.

Ex.: Mr. Yves' class.

's is used when the word doesn't finish with the letter "s".

Ex.: Justine's class

Alexia __ pencil.

Thomas __ apple

Sydney __ desk.

Yves __ computer.

Félix __ shirt.

Isabelle __ phone

Clara __ book.

Léa __ school.

Marilou __ pencil.

Rosalie __ shoes.

Anaïs __ question.

Charles __ snack.

Marie __ chair.

Julia __ headphones

Anne __ bottle.

David __ glasses.

Watch out! Don't use this concept in a word like «it's» because that means "it is" !
