Companies in many parts of the world are relaxing the rules about what is appropriate to wear to work. The days of conservative suits for everyone in business are gone. Many U.S. companies have “casual Friday,” a day when less conservative attire is acceptable. Many people in the computer world wear casual clothes all the time. In warmer climates, people who work in offices frequently
