Making art with found materials is not a new idea. Recycled paper, cloth and metal goods can become important pictures and sculptures. An artist near Washington, D.C just had her recycled art on exhibit at the Prince George's African American Museum and Cultural Center in Maryland. She uses a material found in every American home.

Plastic bags are not costly to produce. They are also strong and easy to carry. This is why they are a popular container in much of the world.

Tips to Plant a Tree

Here are some tips to plant a tree easily, as follow:

- 1) Dig a hole as deep as the root ball and twice as wide
- 2) Check to see if the soil around the hole is too hard. If it is, loosen it up a bit with a shovel
- 3) Remove the container from the root ball. (the root are like the tree's blood vessels ang they work best if they are not all twisted and knotted up, so you mght need to straighten them out if they are circling around after having grown in the container)
- 4) Place the tree in the hole. Make sure the soil is at the same level on the tree as the tree grew in the darden center
- 5) Fill in the hole around the root-ball eith soil and pack the soil with your hands and feet to make sure that there are no air pockets.
- 6) Make a little dam around the base of the tree, as wide as the hole, with left-over soil or grass clumps to hold in the water
- 7) Give your new tree a good soaking with water to help settle into its new home
