Subject Pronouns

We use before a verb:

I live in Italy.

We go to the cinema every Saturday.

They don't speak English.

Object Pronouns

We use after a verb, as a verb's object.

I like **him**.

We speak to **them** every day.

He told **us** in the morning.

Possessive Adjectives

We use to show possession before nouns.

My name is James.

His car is blue.

Our house is in Liguria Street.
