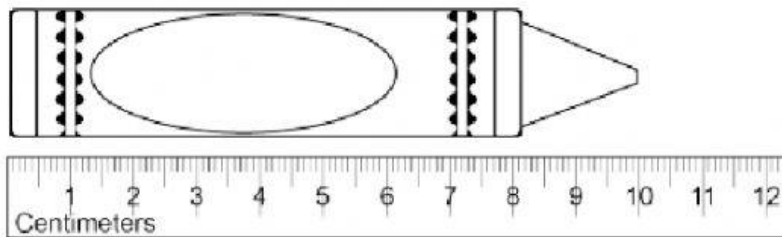

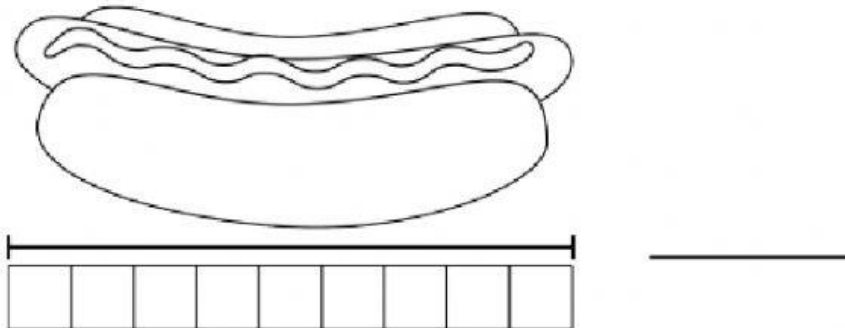

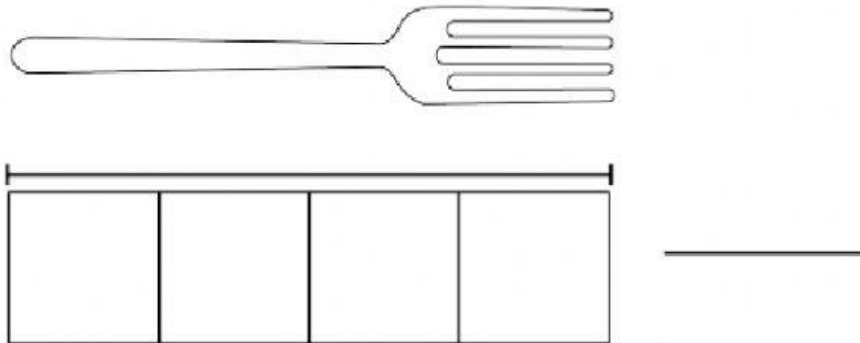
3. Julia bought a jump rope for her friend and measured half of it. Her measurement for half of the jump rope was about 50 inches. About how long is the whole jump rope?
