It is difficult to **distinguish** between the original mythological and folklore ideas on the rose and the emotional excess surrounding the flower due to the rose's popularity in everyday life. Nonetheless, if we examine the beliefs, we see that the rose is much more than a symbol of romantic love expressed by every little poet and painter. Death is one of the rose's most prominent cultural associations. In fact, Roman wills commonly required that roses should be planted on the tombs of the dead. In Switzerland, cemeteries are still referred to as rose gardens. The Saxons connected the rose with life and believed that when a child passed away, the figure of death may be seen outside the home **plucking** a rose. Roses have always been a symbol of female **attractiveness**. Shakespeare uses the rose more than any other flower, frequently using it as a symbol of all that is beautiful and good. For the Arabs, however, the rose symbolized male rather than feminine beauty.

Passage 2

A new hotline has been set up in New York so that people can tell the authorities about their bad neighbors. The hotline will be advertised on posters and flyers. It is part of a \$90 million plan to stop people from acting badly on the streets of New York. Residents will be able to call the hotline to report things like graffiti, cars that have been left on the street, and loud behavior.

People are calling the program a "ASBO hotline," which stands for "antisocial behavior orders." The program has "one nationwide number. After the caller gives their zip code, they are routed through to their local office.

Each complaint will be handled by a local body made up of the police, local authorities, and other groups. This body will follow the instructions of the government's antisocial behavior section. A government spokesman said that complaints are sent to the right agency as soon as they are made. But people will be told to go straight to the police with more significant situations.
