

Roller coasters

Theme parks around the world compete to have the highest, fastest and tallest roller coasters. They're all great, but which roller coasters are the most impressive?

Kingda Ka is a roller coaster in a theme park called Six Flags Great Adventure in New Jersey, in the USA. It's the world's tallest roller coaster (an incredible 139 metres!) and the world's second fastest roller coaster (206 kilometres per hour).

The fastest roller coaster in the world is called **Formula Rossa**. It's in the Ferrari World theme park in the United Arab Emirates. It reaches speeds of 239 kilometres per hour. It's not the tallest, but it's not short, with a height of 52 metres.

Red Force is a roller coaster in Port Aventura in Spain. It is Europe's tallest and fastest roller coaster! It's got a top speed of 180 kilometres per hour, and it is 112 metres tall.

The longest roller coaster in the world is called **Steel Dragon**. This impressive roller coaster is in the Nagashima Spa Land theme park in Japan. It's 2,479 metres long! It takes about 4 minutes to complete the ride at 153 kilometres per hour.

T Express at Everland in South Korea is the tallest wooden roller coaster in the world. It's 56 metres tall, 1,641 metres long and reaches 103 kilometres per hour. In 2010 it was ranked as the world's best wooden coaster!
