● Positive

- He / she / it **has been** to France.

● Negative

- I / you / we / they **haven't + been** to France.
- He / she / it **hasn't been** to France.

● Question

- **Have** I / you / we / they **been** to France?
- **Has** he / she / it **been** to France?

Yes, I have
No, I haven't.

Yes, he has.
No, he hasn't.
