	SIMPLE PRESENT	PRESENT CONTINUOUS
Definition	Routines and permanent situations	Actions happening at the moment of speaking or around the moment of speaking
Key words	always, often, usually, sometimes, hardly ever, never, every day, every week, every year, on Mondays	now, at the moment, Look!, Listen!
Forms	Infinitive 3rd person singular (he, she, it) verb + (s) (es) (i+es)	to be (am, are, is) + verb + ing
Affirmative	I work here. / He works here.	I am working now. / He is working now.
Negative	I don't (do not) <u>work</u> here. / He doesn't (does not) <u>work</u> here.	I'm not working now. / She isn't working now.
Interrogative	Do you <u>work</u> here? Does he <u>work</u> here?	Am I <u>working</u> now? Is she <u>working</u> now?



STATIVE VERBS: do NOT use them in continuous forms, only SIMPLE.
