


We use **THERE IS** or **THERE ARE** to describe what is or is not in a place.

As you can imagine, we use **THERE IS** to talk about things in the singular and **THERE ARE** for the plural.

Usamos **THERE IS** y **THERE ARE** para describir que hay o no en un lugar.

Cómo puedes imaginar, usamos **THERE IS** para hablar sobre cosas en singular y **THERE ARE** para el plural.

SINGULAR		There is a monster
PLURAL		There are three monsters

What happens to negative sentences? it is very simple, we just have to deny the verb **TO BE**.

So, these expressions would be **THERE ISN'T** or **THERE AREN'T**

¿Qué ocurre con las frases en negativa? es muy sencillo, nosotros sólo tenemos que negar el verbo **TO BE**.

Así estas expresiones serían **THERE ISN'T** o **THERE AREN'T**

SINGULAR		There isn't an apple on the table
PLURAL		There aren't bananas under the table

Finally, let's see how the interrogative sentences work. Indeed, we just have to change the order.

Y finalmente veamos cómo funcionan las frases interrogativas. Efectivamente, solo tenemos que cambiar el orden.

SINGULAR		Is there a chimney in your house? Yes, there is / No there isn't
PLURAL		Are there four windows in your house? Yes, there are / No, there aren't

AFF.	There is a cinema	There are two parks
NEG.	There isn't an airport	There aren't four schools
INT.	Is there a bank	Are there two pet shops?


