

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

Verb TO BE + Verb-ing

Study → Studying	Run → running
Sleep → Sleeping	Have → Having

AFFIRMATIVE

I am eating a banana

You are studying English

He is running

She is having a shower

They are sleeping

NEGATIVE

I am not eating a banana

You aren't studying English

He isn't running

She isn't having a shower

They aren't sleeping

INTERROGATIVE

Am I eating a banana?

Are you studying English? Yes, I am. / No, I am not.

Is he running? Yes, he is. / No, he isn't.

Is she having a shower? Yes, she is. / No she isn't.

Are they sleeping? Yes, they are. / No they aren't.
