ASK (SO)

EXAMPLES:

-She asked him: 'Why wasn't Judy at your party?' (asked)

She asked him why Judy hadn't been at her party.

- 'Why don't the police report the crime, Mr Smith?' the judge asked. (asked)

The Judge asked Mr. Smith why the police didn't report the crime.

- 'Why won't you let me in, Sue?' he asked. (wanted to know)

He wanted to know why Sue wouldn't let him in.

WH- QUESTIONS

IF - WHETHER QUESTIONS

if or whether (the choice is optional) is used for reported questions that do not start with a wh- words

He asked if I was hungry.

EXAMPLES

-She asked him: 'Are you listening to me?' (asked)

She asked him if he was listening to her.

- 'Do you know who broke this window?' he asked

He asked if I knew who had broken that window.
