Marie Curie was born in Poland in 1867. She was the youngest of five children. She studied secretly at a secret university. Later, she studied physics, chemistry and math at the university of Paris. In 1895, she married Pierre Curie, who was a physics and chemistry teacher. She was the first woman to receive a Nobel Prize. She discovered and isolated the elements radium and polonium. Also, she developed mobile X-ray units. She died in 1934 from long-term to radiation.






