## Grammar like/have got

Look at the charts below. Pay attention to the changes with **he/ she** and **it**:

### LIKE

| Affirmative                 | Negative                          | Question                      |                                              |
|-----------------------------|-----------------------------------|-------------------------------|----------------------------------------------|
| I<br>You<br>We like<br>They | I<br>You<br>We don't like<br>They | Do I like...?                 |                                              |
|                             |                                   | Do <b>you</b> like...?        | Yes, <b>I</b> do<br>No, <b>I</b> don't       |
| He/She/It <b>likes</b>      | He/she/It <b>doesn't</b> like     | <b>Does</b> he/she/it like..? | Yes, <b>he does</b><br>No, <b>he doesn't</b> |

### HAVE GOT

| Affirmative                     | Negative                           | Question                     |                                            |
|---------------------------------|------------------------------------|------------------------------|--------------------------------------------|
| I<br>You<br>We have got<br>They | I<br>You<br>We haven't got<br>They | Have I got...?               |                                            |
|                                 |                                    | Have <b>you</b> got...?      | Yes, <b>I</b> have<br>No, <b>I</b> haven't |
| He/She/It <b>has got</b>        | He/she/It <b>hasn't got</b>        | <b>Has</b> he/she/it got...? | Yes, <b>he has</b><br>No, <b>he hasn't</b> |
