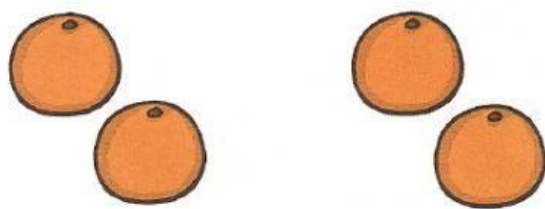


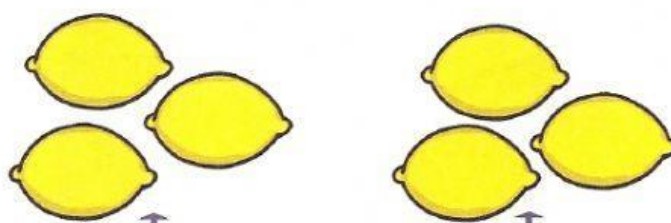

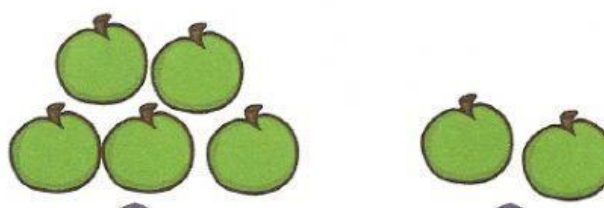
Two groups of two oranges each are shown above the equation. The first group has two oranges, and the second group also has two oranges.
