



Now, practise Present Perfect following the example

A) Write a suitable sentence using the PRESENT PERFECT TENSE :

1. Ann's hair was dirty. Now it's clean. (wash) **Ann has washed her hair**
2. Tom was 80 kg. Now he's 70. (lose weight)
3. My sister is looking for her pen. (lose)
4. Mary is on holiday in France. (go)
5. Look! Mrs. Smith has got a lot of packages. (buy)
6. I can't eat anything now. (eat too much)
7. Mrs. Jenkins is very tired. (clean / house)
8. Tony needs a holiday. (work / hard / this year)

B) Use PRESENT PERFECT after BECAUSE:

Example: She can't go to the party. (catch a cold)

She can't go to the party *because she has caught a cold.* -----but I haven't caught a cold

1. He can't walk very fast. (hurt / leg)
2. I can't get in. (lose / key)
3. I know this story very well. (see the film)
4. I can't post the letter. (not put / stamp / on it)
5. He can't stand up. (eat too much)
