Eco-cities

Some friends of nature are creating Eco-cities, cities that are created to be eco - friendly. In addition, eco-cities use **sustainable** energy by using solar and wind power to protect the polar bears. Eco-cities also have green space, including parks and forests that give a natural habitat for **wildlife**, and community gardens where residents can plant and grow fruits and vegetables.

Also, the **buildings** in an eco-city are constructed using ecological materials, such as recycled bricks made of plastic bottles and **wood**. Creating all the eco-cities, people think we should start helping our planet.
