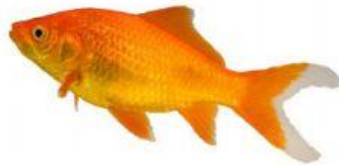


# Life Skills: Cat Pet Chores

## Daily Cat Chores

People who have cats for pets have many chores that need to be done. Feeding and giving a cat clean water every day are examples of daily pet chores.



Cats use a litter box to pee and poop. The litter box is stored inside your home. The litter box is filled with a loose sandy material that absorbs moisture and smells. Cats use their paws to cover their pee and poop.



## Daily Cat Chores

A litter box needs to be clean everyday to stop your home from smelling bad. Cleaning the litter box is an example of a daily pet chore. A scoop and bag is needed to clean the litter box.



Playing with a cat is another example of a daily pet chore. Cats love to play chase games with feathers and balls. These games are examples of ways people play and exercise their pet cats.





## **Weekly Cat Chores**

Brushing your cat's fur is an example of a weekly pet chore. Brushing their hair helps prevent hair from getting into furniture and carpets. It also keeps their hair clean. There are special brushes you use to do this chore.



## **Occasional and Seasonal Cat Chores**

Trimming your cat's claws and taking them to the vet are examples of occasional and seasonal pet chores. A cat's claws get long and need to be trimmed so they don't hurt their paws. The vet also makes sure your cat is in good health.
