Prepositions with future time expressions

- Notice how prepositions are used in future time expressions:

*My friends are having a party **on** Saturday.*

*We're moving house **in** two weeks' (time). (= two weeks from now)*

*I'm seeing my cousins **at** the weekend.*

- Phrases with *next* and *this* do not have a preposition:

We're going on holiday \emptyset next week/this weekend/tomorrow.
