Prepositions with future time expressions

- Notice how prepositions are used in future time expressions:

 My friends are baying a party on Saturday.
 - My friends are having a party on Saturday.

 We're moving house in two weeks' (time). (= two weeks from now)
 - I'm seeing my cousins at the weekend.
- Phrases with next and this do not have a preposition:
 We're going on holiday ø next week/this weekend/ tomorrow.
