

Tag questions: can be used to confirm information that we think is true or as an ice-breaker, to make small talk or keep a conversation going.

When the statement is affirmative, use a negative tag.

I am a great student, **aren't I?** (exception)

Harry was at the party, \_\_\_\_\_?
