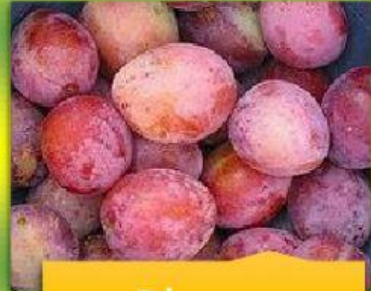

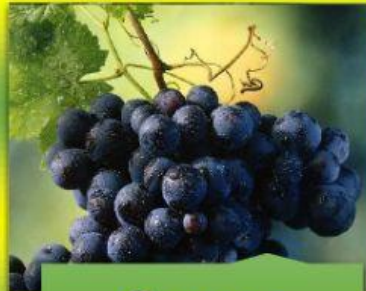

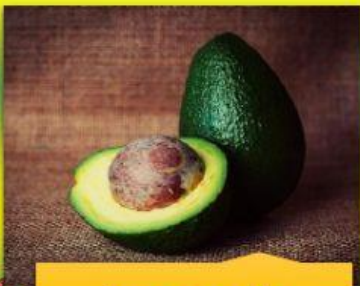

Grammar

A / AN + SINGULAR NOUNS

A + consonant sound: there is a pineapple on the table 

An + vowel sound: there is an aubergine on the table 

SOME / ANY + PLURAL NOUNS

Affirmative sentences: SOME 

There are some grapes on the plate 

Negative sentences: ANY 

There aren't any strawberries in the fruit basket 

Interrogative sentences: ANY 

Are there any oranges in the fridge? 

<i>There is/isn't...</i>	<i>a/an</i>
<i>Is there...?</i>	<i>a/an</i>
<i>There are...</i>	<i>some</i>
<i>There aren't...</i>	<i>any</i>
<i>Are there...?</i>	<i>any</i>
