A) PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE – QUESTION FORMS

Examples:

- Is he studying Maths exam.
- Are they feeding the street cats?
- Am I doing my English homework now?
- Where are you going now?
- What is your father doing now?
- Why is their mom crying now?

Present Continuous Tense (?)

he
Is + **she** + **Verb 1 (ing)** ?
it

*Example: Is Claire reading a book?
Is she reading a book?*

I
Am + **I** + **Verb 1 (ing)** ?

Example: Am I speaking English well?

you
Are + **they** + **Verb 1 (ing)** ?
we

Example: Are they reading novels?

B) PRESENT CONTINUOUS TENSE – NEGATIVE FORMS

Examples:

I am not going to school these days.

They are not (aren't) listening to rap. It's pop.

Clara and I are not studying English.

It is not eating seed now.

The puppies are not playing with the ball. It is so hot today.

Affirmative and Negative Forms

Affirmative :

I am playing

You are playing

He is playing

She is playing

It is playing

We are playing

You are playing

Negative

I am not playing

You are not playing

He is not playing

She is not playing

It is not playing

We are not playing

You are not playing

C) OTHER YES/NO QUESTIONS

Examples:

Are there any candies in the box?

Is there any milk in the kitchen?

Are you a student?

Is he an actor?

Am I your best friend, Ceyda?

Do you like football?

Does her sister sing in French?

Can your father make a cake well?

May I sit down next to you?

Yes or No Questions

Question	Affirmative Answer	Negative Answer
Do you...?	Yes, I do./Yes, we do.	No, I don't./No, we don't.
Does he...?	Yes, he does.	No, he doesn't.
Can we...?	Yes, we can.	No, we can't.
Have you got...?	Yes, I have./Yes, we have.	No, I haven't./No, we haven't.
Has he got...?	Yes, he has.	No, he hasn't.
Would you like...?	Yes, I would./Yes, we would.	No, I wouldn't./No, we wouldn't.
Are you...?	Yes, I am.	No, I'm not.
Were you...?	Yes, I was./Yes, we were.	No, I wasn't./No, we weren't.
Was it...?	Yes, it was.	No, it wasn't.
Did they...?	Yes, they did.	No, they didn't.



Yes or no questions can only have yes or no as an answer.
The answers to closed questions are called short answers.
