We use **SHALL** to make an offer or to make a suggestion, for e.g.
a girl: I'm very hungry.

mum: Shall I make a sandwich for you?

a woman: It is very cold in here.

a man: Shall I turn on the heating?

a student: I don't understand this task.

a friend: Shall I help you?

Mark: I'm bored.

Peter: Shall we go to the cinema?
