Have you got any plans for the summer?

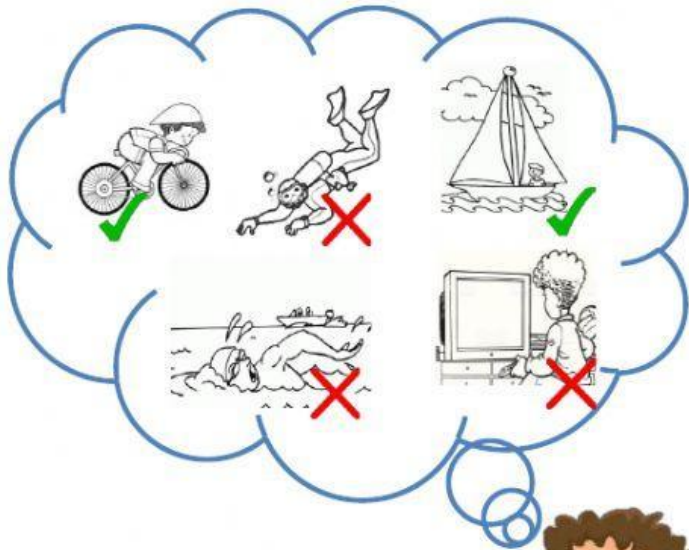
I'm going to go to a camping in Spain with my family.

We are also going to sleep in a big tent. I find it exciting!

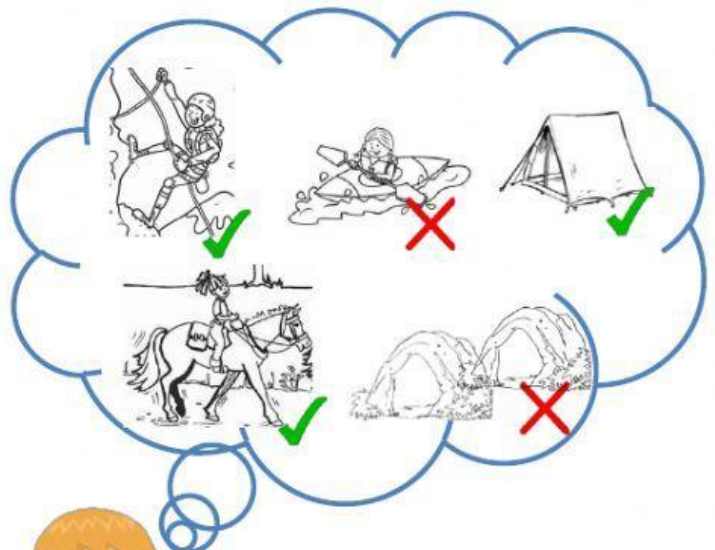

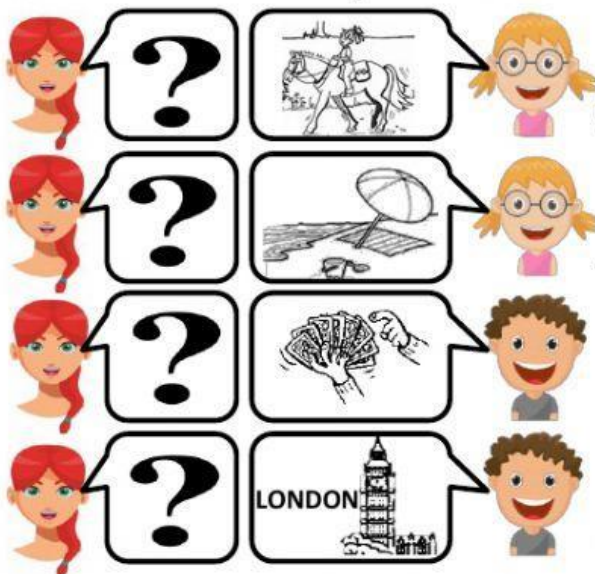
