



Seasons

There are four seasons in a year: spring, summer, autumn and winter.
The Earth spins around the Sun and the seasons change.

In **spring**, everything is green. Trees grow their leaves and plants bloom. Birds sing and many animals have their babies in spring. It is warm and sometimes it is rainy.



In **summer**, the Sun shines and it is hot. Fruit grows on trees. Days are long and nights are short. Children can play outside, eat ice cream and watermelon. We go to the beach or the swimming-pool.



In **autumn**, leaves change colour and fall from the trees. Some animals collect food before winter comes. The weather is rainy and windy and the air is cool. Some people call this season fall.



In **winter**, trees don't have leaves. It is cold and sometimes it is snowy. Some animals, like bats or bears go to sleep. This is called *hibernation*. Days are short and nights are long.
