➡ Past Simple: to be. Interrogative, affirmative and negative form.

Verb BE

Subject Pronouns	Simple Present	Simple Past
I	AM	WAS
HE	IS	WAS
SHE	IS	WAS
IT	IS	WAS
YOU	ARE	WERE
WE	ARE	WERE
THEY	ARE	WERE

Remember: vamos a utilizar el verbo BE en su forma de Presente Simple (AM IS ARE) dependiendo de la persona de la que estamos hablando.

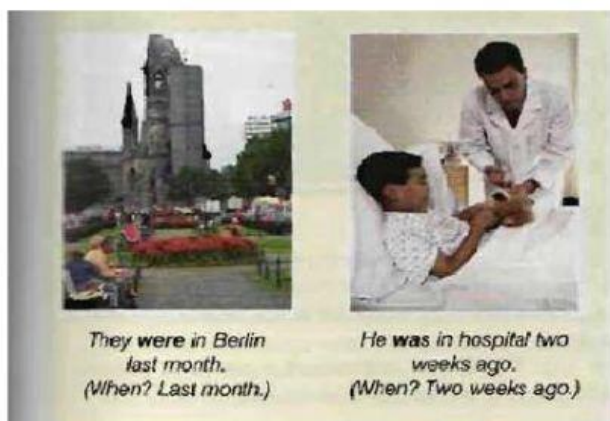
En cambio en Pasado simple, solamente tenemos formas de uso (WAS;WERE)

USE:

We use the Past Simple for actions which finished at a definite stated time in the past. That is, we know when the action happened.

Time Expressions (used with the Past Simple include:

- Yesterday
- Last week, last month, last year,....
- Two days ago, ...weeks ago,years ago.
- In 2009, in 1983...etc.



Verb BE: Affirmative, Negative and Interrogative form.

Affirmative	Negative		Interrogative
	Long form	Short form	
I was	I was not	I wasn't	Was I?
You were	You were not	You weren't	Were you?
He was	He was not	He wasn't	Was he?
She was	She was not	She wasn't	Was she?
It was	It was not	It wasn't	Was it?
We were	We were not	We weren't	Were we?
You were	You were not	You weren't	Were you?
They were	They were not	They weren't	Were they?

Short answers.

Were you ...?	Yes, I was/we were. No, I wasn't/we weren't.
Was he/she/it ...?	Yes, he/she/it was. No, he/she/it wasn't.
Were they ...?	Yes, they were. No, they weren't.
Note: We use the past simple to talk about people who are no longer alive.	

In short answers we only use **YES** or **NO**, the personal pronoun and the verb form: **WAS/WASNT** or **WERE/WEREN'T**. (We do not repeat the whole question.

Example:

WAS she at home last night?

YES, she was.

No, she wasn't.
