indirect statement:

He **said** that he loved her so much.

RULES TO FOLLOW

TENSES:

PRESENT TENSE

→

PAST TENSE

He said, "I **love** her so much".

He said that he **loved** her so much.

PAST TENSE

→

PAST PERFECT TENSE

He said, "I **loved** her so much".

He said that he **had loved** her so much.

PRESENT PERFECT

→

PAST PERFECT TENSE

He said, "I **have loved** her so much".

He said that he **had loved** her so much.

WILL FUTURE

→

WOULD

He said, "I **will love** her so much".

He said that he **would love** her so much.
