This is one of the most beautiful journeys in Argentina: the Seven Lakes' road. Nature slowly comes back to life, flowers show up as a miracle under the snow, the forest is colorful and you can hear the sound of singing birds. All that beauty is there, waiting for you, on a road that joins Villa La Angostura with San Martin de Los Andes. The 7 Lagos Route is a two-way, paved highway which is in good condition, on Argentina's famous Ruta Nacional 40.

The best time to visit the Ruta de los Siete Lagos is in summer or spring (from September to February). In summer, you find the warmest weather, sunny days and the chance of taking a dip in one or two of the most beautiful lakes in Argentina. Camping sites are open, as are the stores along the route that sell food and supplies. This is of course the most expensive time to visit.

If you want to visit it in winter, prepare for snow and extremely cold weather. Bariloche is a popular ski town in winter, to give you an idea of how much snow you can expect during this time of year.

There are three ways you can traverse the Ruta de los Siete Lagos: By car, by bike or on a tour. One of the quickest and easiest ways to see the Ruta de los Siete Lagos is by car. You can easily do the route in a day, and have time to stop at miradores (viewpoints).

If you have a few more days you can bike the route, it's an unforgettable experience. Do you need to be fit? After biking the route myself, I would say that you definitely need a moderate to high level of fitness. Prepare in advance if you plan to bike the 7 Lakes Route.
