- Where is 'ch'?

ch at the beginning = child children ch at the end = K (stomach<sup>K</sup>)?


- Where is 'e'?

e at the beginning = ear, end or egg e at the end = silent (no sound) ache<sup>AAAK</sup>

- 2 vowels together = 1 sound ea = E like ear OR ea = e like head

- 2 consonants together = 1 sound gh = F c ou gh = cough<sup>K o F</sup>
