## **HUEVOS RANCHEROS**

Fried eggs with tortillas topped with salsa fresca, chili peppers, onion, and cilantro; commonly served with beans and rice



## **ACKEE AND SALTFISH**

Salt cod sautéed with boiled ackee, onions, Scotch bonnet peppers, tomatoes, and spices; served with breadfruit, bread, and fried plantains



## **CACHAPAS**

Pancakes made from corn dough, often lumpy with pieces of corn kernels; filled with queso de mano and occasionally pork



## **CHANGUA**

Thick soup made from milk, eggs, and potatoes; eaten with a piece of stale bread called calado, which softens in the soup



## **TOSTADA WITH CAFE CON LECHE**

Buttered bread dipped into a strong coffee and milk beverage; often served with fruit



### TARTINES

Slices of baguette topped with butter, jam, and chocolate paste; often served with a cup of coffee or juice



### CHOCOLATE CON CHURROS

Thick hot chocolate with doughnut-like fritters



### PRIMA COLAZIONE

Caffè latte with bread or croissants topped with butter and jam



### JIANBING

Flour and egg crepes with a variety of toppings, such as soybeans, eggs, peanuts, pork, youtiao, and crispy fried crackers; a popular street food



### STEAMED RICE AND MISO SOUP

Steamed rice, miso soup, and pickles like takuan or umeboshi. Raw egg and nori (seaweed) are often included.

**BAGEL WITH CREAM CHEESE**  
Soft, mild cheese slathered between rings made from yeasted wheat dough. Bagels are boiled in water briefly, then baked.

**HOMESTYLE BREAKFAST**  
Eggs, bacon, toast, and pancakes with syrup



**FULL ENGLISH BREAKFAST**  
Bacon, poached eggs, grilled tomatoes, fried mushrooms, fried bread, sausages, black pudding, baked beans, and bubble and squeak (boiled potatoes and cabbage)

**WEET-BIX**  
Compressed toasted flakes of wheat cereal with milk; eaten with toast topped with marmalade or Vegemite
