



# ASKING FOR AGREEMENT

## QUESTION TAGS WITH THE VERB TO BE

Remember, we use **question tags** to ask for confirmation when we know something is true.

Affirmative sentence You are American,	Negative question tag Aren't you?
Negative sentence You aren't American,	Positive question tag Are you?
Watch out! I'm American,	Aren't I?
