**Sprint**

Walk briskly for aerobic exercise

**Hike**

Run very fast for a short distance

**Power walk**

Take a long walk for exercise, exploration or leisure.

**Limp**

Move very fast through the air with a buzzing sound.

**Whizz**

Walk with difficulty because of an injury to the leg



**Toddle**

Leave from a place or location

**Stomp**

Walk with unsteady steps, usually referred to very young children who are learning to walk

**Wobble**

Walk with heavy steps to express anger or displeasure

**Crash**

Shiver like a leaf from side to side. Shake like a jelly.

**Depart**

Hit against something else violently.
