We use **USED TO** to talk about habits in the past or about situations that are not true anymore.

Past: **USED TO** (to USE TO)

- (+) People **USED TO** walk long distances in the past.
- (-) Ed and Louise **DIDN'T USE TO** get up early when it rained.
- (?) **DID** you **USE TO** watch TV when you were younger?

Present: **USUALLY**

- (+) My parents **USUALLY** speak very quietly.
- (-) My sister doesn't **USUALLY** talk with strangers.
- (?) Are you **USUALLY** allowed to stay out late at night?
