


5.1.2 Able to use pronouns correctly and appropriately: (a) interrogative



The words *who*, *what*, *whom* and *which* are interrogative pronouns.



### Interrogative Pronouns

- ☺ Interrogative pronouns are used to ask questions.
- ☺ We use an interrogative pronoun to replace the thing that we do not know.
- ☺ We use *who*, *whom* and sometimes *which* to refer to people.
- ☺ We use *what* and *which* to refer to things and animals.
