	Document which sets out details of your work history, qualifications, skills, and abilities.

	When you are made to leave your job.
	A meeting with a prospective employer.
	When you leave your job because your employer no longer has any work for you.
	Someone you might work for at some point in the future.
	Written confirmation of your work history and qualities by someone.
	Something essential for employees who work in a job to either have or be able to do.
	To leave your job voluntarily.
	Having a lot of training/experience.
	Document with your resume to provide additional information on your skills and experience
