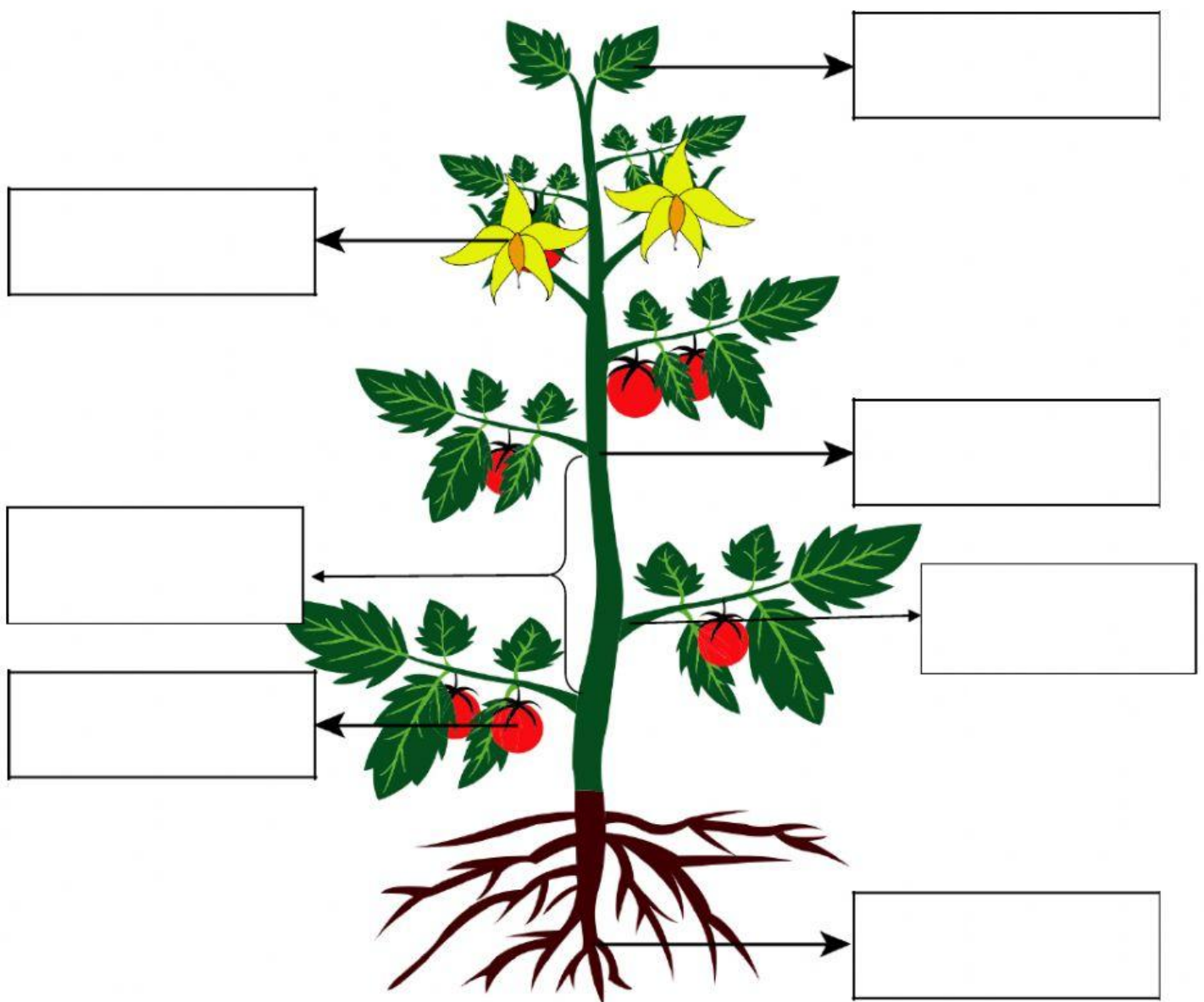


Parts of a Plant

c. A part of a plant that makes seeds or fruits.

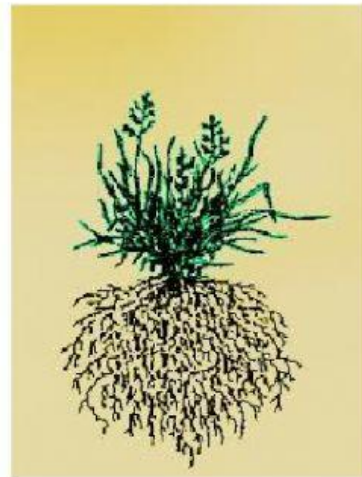
