Los artículos **A / AN** se utilizan para indicar UNA COSA en general, no algo específico.

*E.g. "I need a pen," or
"I want an orange." → We AREN'T
referring to a specific pen or orange.*

**DEFINITE ARTICLE: THE**

El artículo **THE** se utiliza para indicar algo en específico.

*E.g. The cake you bought yesterday was very expensive!
I ate an apple yesterday. The apple was juicy and delicious.*

NO ARTICLE

El artículo se omite cuando hablo en general, y se lo usa con sustantivos incontables y con contables en plural:

*E.g. I love chocolate.
Bananas are cheap.
Cheetahs are the fastest animals in the world. (NOT THE
CHEETAHS)*
