

## BOTH-EITHER- NEITHER

### BOTH: her ikisi de

Cümlede daima çoğul olarak düşünülür.

- Both students are from China.

\*"both of" olarak da kullanılabilir.

- We decided to buy both of the T-shirts.

► Both ... and ...: "hem ..... hem de"

- Both Emily and John were happy when they went to seaside.

- I felt both nervous and surprised about the latest news.

### EITHER: ikisinden biri

Cümlede daima tekil olarak düşünülür.

- Either actor can act in this play. They are both very talented.

"either of ..." yapısından sonra gelen isimler her zaman çoğul olur.

- I haven't been to either of those restaurants.

► either ... or ...: "ya ... ya da"

- Either you come or I'll go out without you.

### NEITHER: ikisinden hiçbirisi

Cümlede daima tekil olarak düşünülür

- Neither woman likes the dessert.

"Neither of" yapısından sonra gelen isim daima çoğul olur. Bu tür kullanımlarda "neither" hem tekil ve hem de çoğul olarak düşünülebilir.

- Neither of them play / play in the garden.

► neither ... not ...: "Ne ... ne de ..."

- Neither Mary nor Jack agreed with him.

- My mother neither cooked nor cleaned the house.

\*Neither'in olumlu cümle ile kullanımı, either'in olumsuz cümle ile kullanımındaki verdiği manayı verir.

- I want neither of the books = I don't want either of the books

\*Cümle başında kullanılması icap ettiği zaman neither tercih edilir.

- Neither skirt suits her.

\*Neither ve either tekil olarak düşünüldükleri için şahıslarla kullanıldığı zaman üçüncü tekil şahıslar için kullanılan zamirler ile kullanılırlar. ( He, him, his; she, her, her )

- Neither of them can play his guitar.

(İkisi de ( hiçbirisi ) gitarını çalamaz.)
